The Fort Bliss Recycling Program is proud to announce the purchase of two industrial balers; this new equipment will have a positive effect on operations. Unfortunately, due to the increase in commercial traffic and other safety concerns, there will no longer be an indoor drive-through service area inside Bldg. 1336 as of Monday. There is a fully functional voluntary drop-off point directly in front of Bldg. 1336 that is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, except during inclement weather (high winds). Materials collected outdoors are cardboard, newspaper, magazines, plastics #1 & #2, paper, aluminum cans, tin cans, fluorescent tubes, and toner and inkjet cartridges. Plastics #1 include clear water bottles and green soda bottles; plastics #2 include milk and juice jugs, detergent bottles and plastic bags. Wesley Fitzgerald, 51st Maintenance Company, of wrongfully introducing marijuana onto Fort Bliss and wrongfully distributing marijuana. The military judge sentenced Fitzgerald to be reduced to the grade of E-1, to forfeit \$800 per month for three months, be confined for three months, and to be discharged from the Army with a bad conduct discharge.
