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U.S. ARMY ANNOUNCES RECORD OF DECISION ON THE FORT BLISS, TEXAS AND NEW MEXICO, MISSION AND MASTER PLAN SUPPLEMENTAL PROGRAMMATIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT (SEIS)

On April 30, 2007, the U.S. Army Installation Management Command signed a Record of Decision (ROD) on the Fort Bliss Mission and Master Plan SEIS selecting Alternative 4 – Proposed Action for implementation. The waiting period following publication of the Final SEIS ended April 23, 2007. The SEIS addressed the environmental impacts associated with proposed changes in land use at Fort Bliss to support Army Transformation and accommodate new units identified under Base Realignment and Closure (BRAC).
